

How to get to Shell Centre

By British Rail

The main exit from Waterloo Station gives access to York Road.

Waterloo East Station connects with London Bridge and Charing Cross Stations.

The exit from Waterloo East leads to the concourse of the main Waterloo Station.

The exit from the Waterloo and City Line, with frequent trains between Bank and Waterloo, gives access to the main concourse of Waterloo Station.

By Underground

Waterloo Underground Station is on the Bakerloo Line, Northern Line and the Jubilee Line. It also has direct connections to the city via the Waterloo & City Line.

Among the stations served with direct connections are Charing Cross, Piccadilly, Oxford Circus, Leicester Square, Baker Street, Marylebone, Paddington and Euston. Change at Embankment from Victoria.

By Private Transport

Approach via York Road, Chicheley Street and Belvedere Road. There is a public car park near the Tower on the other side of Belvedere Road.

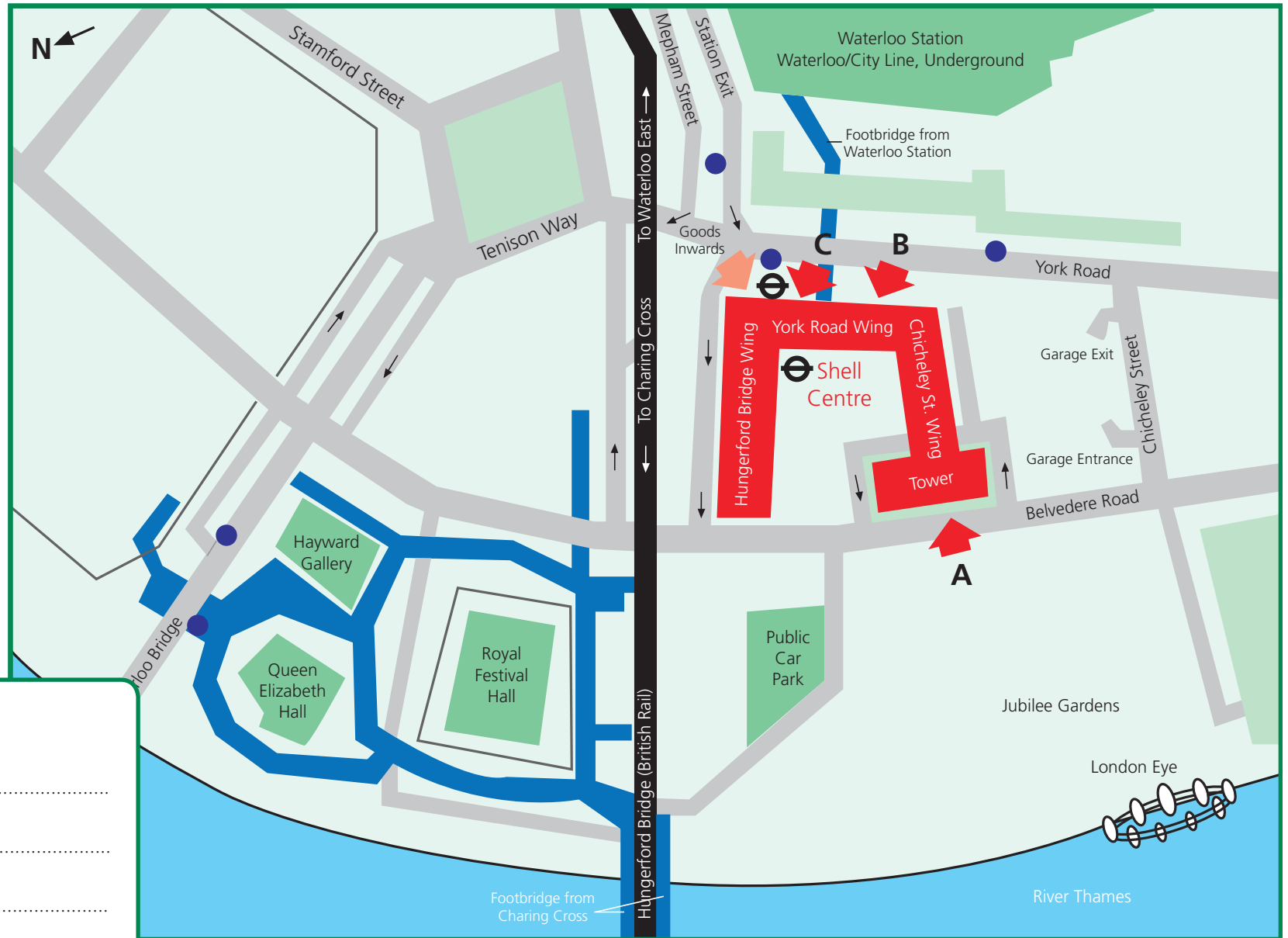
