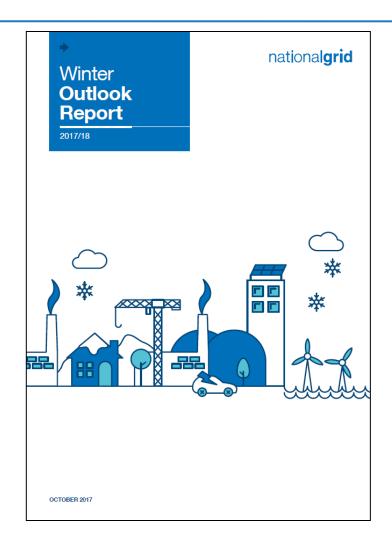

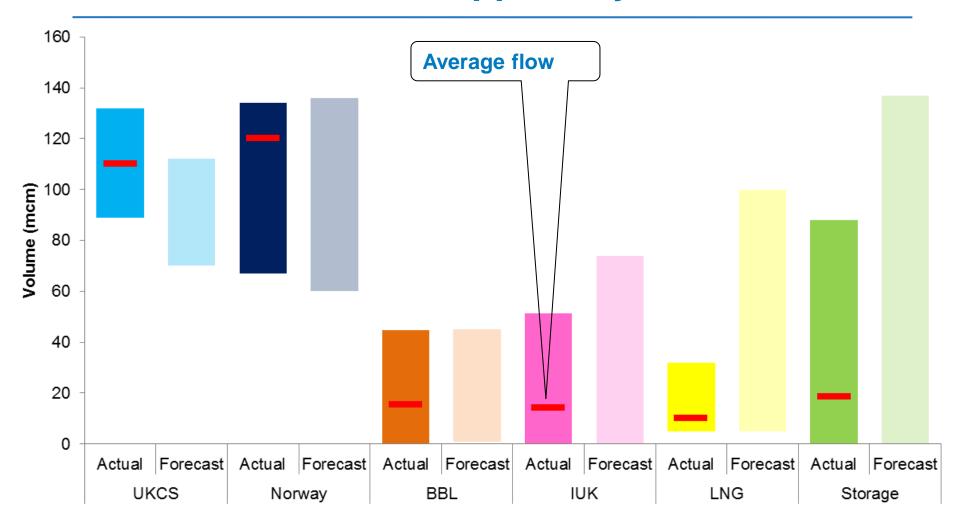
#### Why do we prepare a winter outlook?

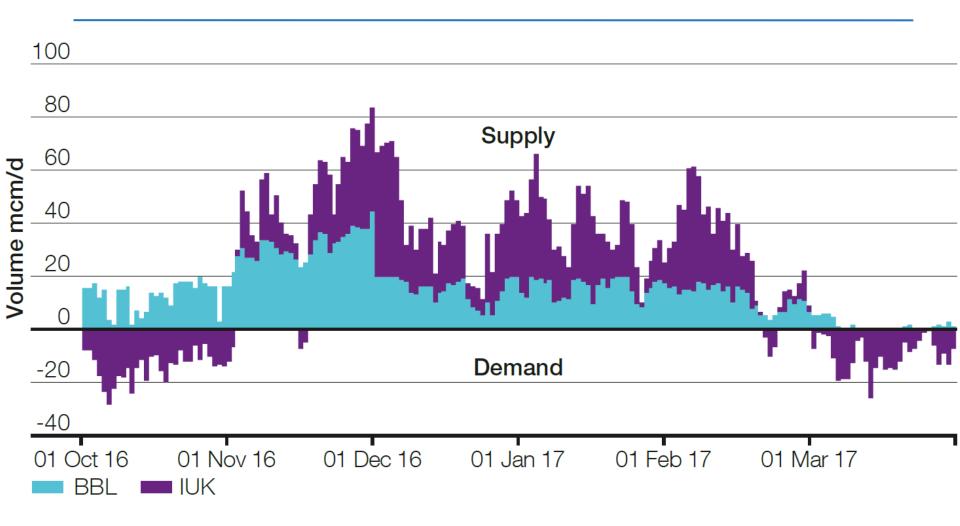

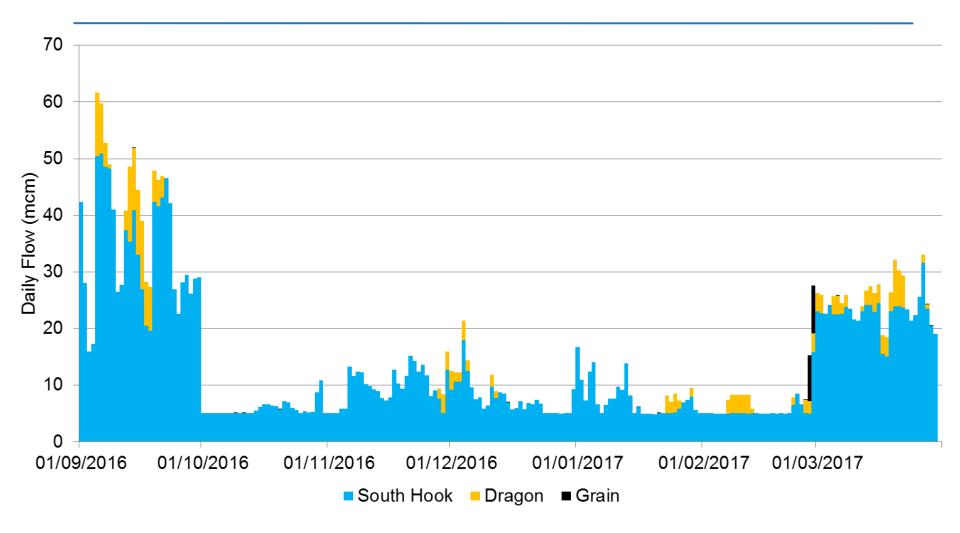
#### Actual and forecast supplies by source



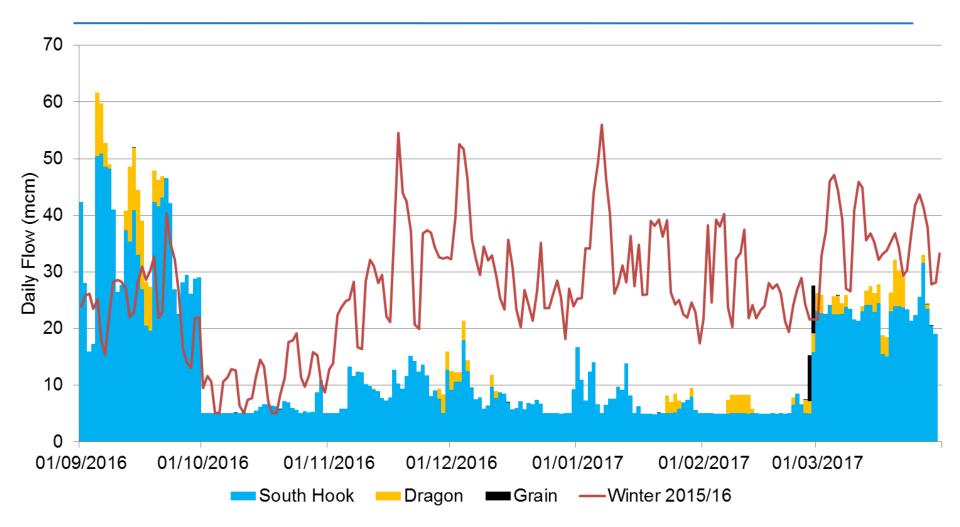
#### Interconnector flows



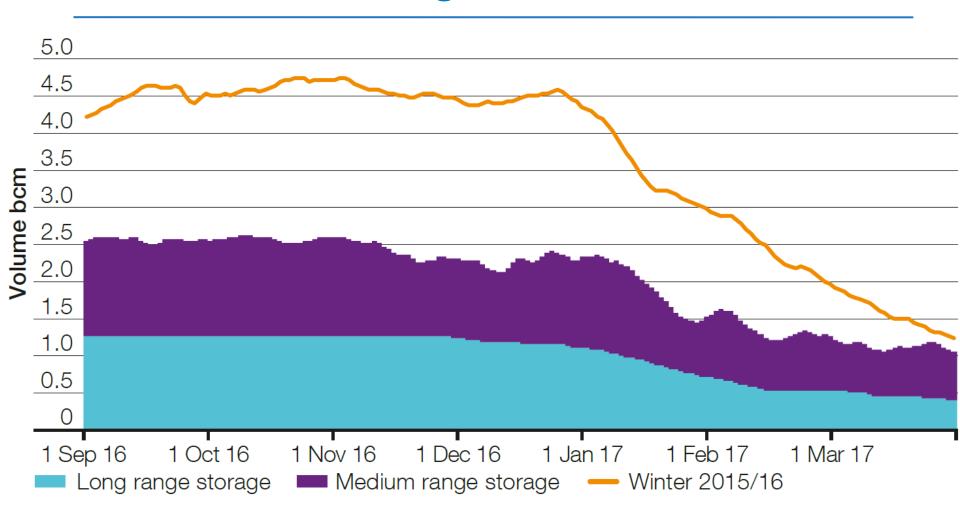

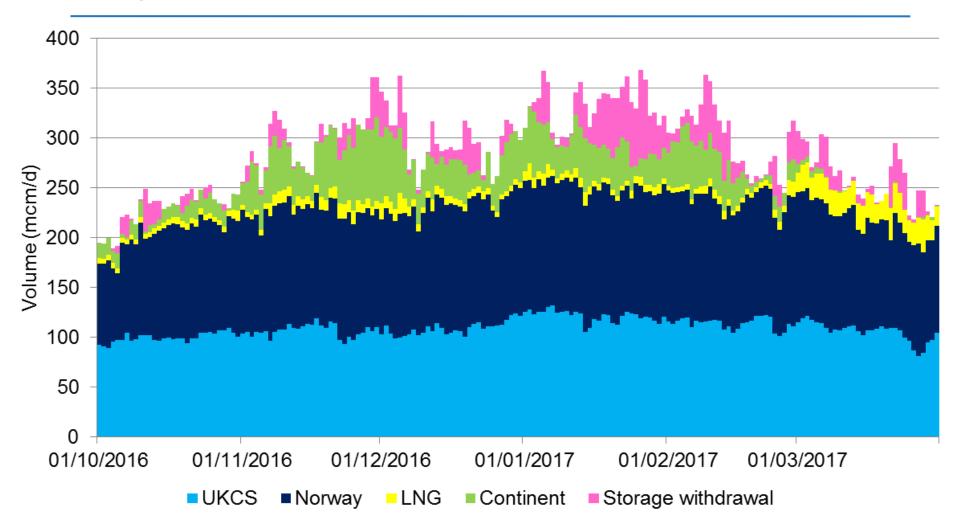

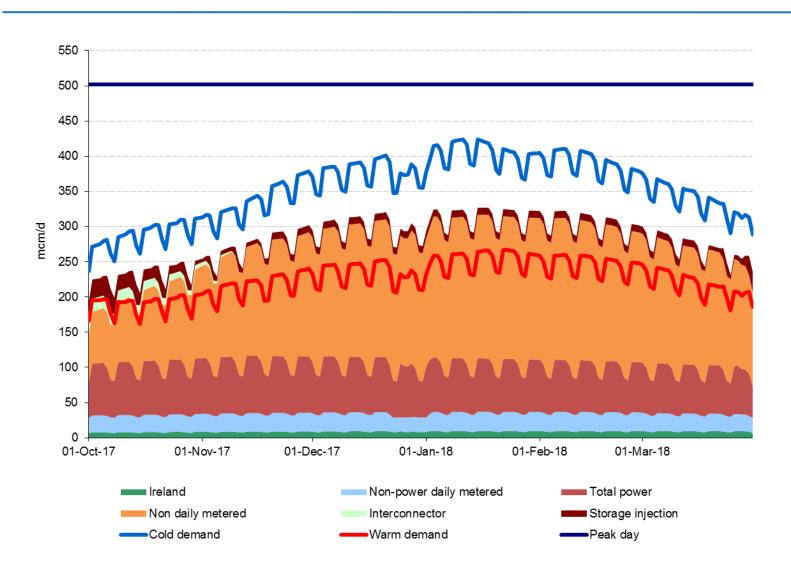

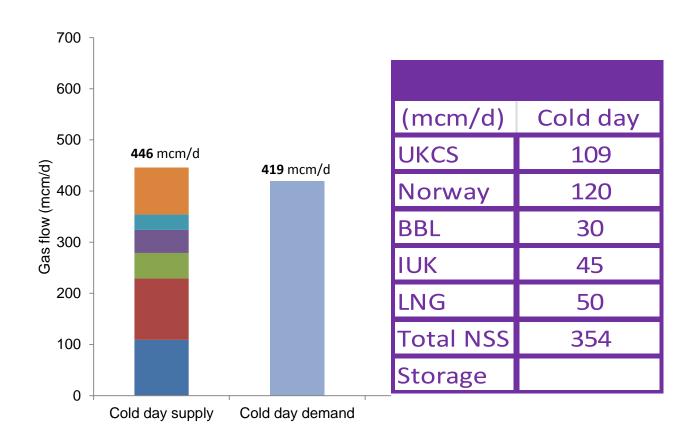

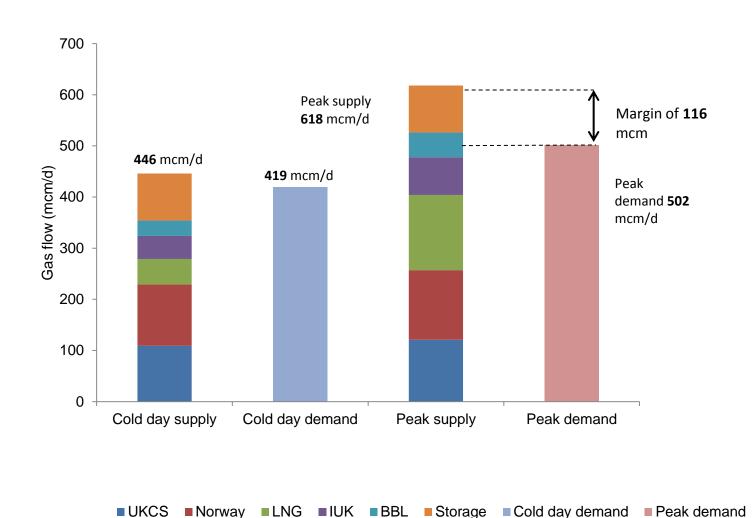
